What needs to happen?



- 1. Develop a national river, lake and **wetland** restoration programme
- 2. Prohibit **wetland drainage** and reform the Arterial Drainage Act 1945
- 3. All **forestry** operations must include a WFD-specific assessment before being permitted
- 4. **Agriculture**: Risk assessments for all intensive farms should be introduced through a permitting/licensing system
- 5. Measures to halt **sewage** discharges to 208 polluted waterbodies.
- **6. The public** must be involved across the **46** catchments and catchment groups resourced to ensure effective engagement
