
How do we collect data?

 Four data sources: closed Coronial files, Hospital In-Patient data (HIPE), register of people on opioid substitution (Central Treatment List) and General Mortality Registry data from the CSO





43% were alone






Non-poisoning deaths, 2011 to 2020

Key messages

- Poisoning deaths continue to rise
- Most poisoning deaths have multiple drugs implicated
 - Opioids most common drug
 - Increase in cocaine
- Opportunities for prevention
- Non-poisoning deaths population burden of drug use
 - Deaths due to hanging among people who use cannabis and cocaine
