The National Voluntary Drug and Alcohol Sector (NVDAS) is a national representative body for voluntary sector organisations in Ireland working in the area of drugs and alcohol. Comprising of 60+ members across Ireland we represent the view of the sector through consultative processes within the National Drugs Strategy fora.

Our aim is to create a strong network of voluntary sector agencies in the alcohol and drugs sector in Ireland that can:

- liaise meaningfully with the state on key policy issues.
- present a consensus view of the sector on key issues where possible.

We welcome the establishment of the Citizens Assembly on Drugs to consider the legislative, policy and operational changes Ireland could make to significantly reduce the harmful impacts of illicit drugs on individuals, families, communities and wider Irish society. For NVDAS members it is a long overdue national conversation.
