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

How do we measure drug treatment demand?

- National Drug Treatment Reporting System (NDTRS)
- We collect data on individual cases
- New cases and returning cases
- The type of data we collect includes: age, gender, living arrangements, employment status, drug types used, treatment type and where it is provided.

Decrease in the numbers reporting **injecting**




Mixing drugs (polydrug use) is common



Drug treatment demand 2022







Powder cocaine	59% cannabis 27% cocaine	16 years
Crack cocaine	55% cannabis 9% cocaine	15 years
Opioids	56% cannabis	15 years
Cannabis	95% cannabis	14 years
Benzodiazepines	60% cannabis 18% benzodiazepines	15 years




Parental status



Of cases with children aged 17 or younger



Key messages

- Over 12,000 cases treated by more than 350 service providers in 2022
- Cocaine, opioids, cannabis and benzodiazepines are the most common drugs generating treatment demand
- Profiles of those treated and their needs differ depending on drugs used
- Problem use of several drugs (polydrug use) is common
- Downward trend for injecting and polydrug use
