










# Distribution of entire population (aged 0 to 109) by history of illegal drug use, 2019




- Never used

# Cannabis use disorder

- 20% of past year users have CUD (~45,000 in Ireland)
- Cannabis is main substance for ~80% of under 18s who enter Rx
- Mainly boys
- All SE Groups
- Issues
  - Mental health
  - Debt
  - School
  - Family






Survey respondents were asked to identify the main problem drug in their area. They had the option of choosing three options from a pre-set list. Cannabis, Crack Cocaine, and Cocaine were identified as the three main problem drugs.


