




The 2019–20 Irish National Drug and Alcohol Survey

93% didn't USe illicit drugs Why?


Drug use Prevalence - Past Year





- Unplugged 7 European Countries (+ Clondalkin!)
- 38% drunkenness & 26% cannabis use last 30 days
- Aimed at **12-14** year olds in school
- Focus on social influence, lifeskills and correction of normative beliefs



Multi-level analyses indicated <u>significant reductions</u> in past-year and pastmonth <u>smoking, friends' substance use, and problems related to substance</u> <u>use</u> and in general at intervention relative to control schools. <u>Significant</u> <u>increases</u> were found in <u>intervention vs. control schools</u> related to students' awareness of school substance use policies, perceived likelihood of getting caught for smoking, and school bonding



- Implement 'Beneficial' or 'Likely to be Beneficial' interventions as per Xchange Registry




