Interagency Approach








The EPI team is overseen by a management group from CDATF, Crosscare and Clondalkin YDAP.

EPI Team	
Position	Role and Responsibility
Prevention Officer	Parents, Policy and Professionals. Overall coordination of the EPI response in formal and informal school settings in the area. Provide policy guidance to schools, work with parent's groups as required and train teachers/other professionals.
	Facilitate meetings, ensure communication between team.
Prevention Worker	Provide evidence based universal programmes to identified school classes. Refer on/introduce to YDAP as required.

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SW Clondalkin	
Substance Use Intervention Worker (North Clondalkin)	Screen, assess and provide under 18's (21's) appropriate substance use interventions to indicated groups. Refer on as appropriate.
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YDAP Coordinator	Triage referrals through schools. Support Prevention officer on policy matters and delivery. Will mentor prevention workers on delivery of i class programmes.
